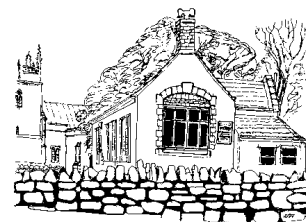

Plummer's Trust and Free School Meals

The school has been given £100 from the Plummer's Trust for parents who may need financial support for the purchase of school uniforms. If you feel that you would like to take advantage of this kind donation, please do come and speak to me in complete confidence.

We have also been reminded by County that there is a system whereby parents can claim financial help with school meals. This would cover the hot lunch as well as provide a packed lunch which the children could put in their own box. If parents are in receipt of Income Support (IS), Income Based Job Seekers Allowance (IBJSA), Guaranteed Element of State Pension Credit, Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 or Child Tax Credit (provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual joint income (as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs) that as of 6th April 2008 does not exceed £15,575), they would be entitled

to claim free school meals for their child. If you feel that you may be able to take advantage of this, again, please come and speak to me and I will let you have the relevant forms and of course, there will be complete confidentiality.
